SMART(ER)	Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, Timed (phased) (Exciting - Evaluation) (Review - Recordable)
VAK	Visual, Audio, Kinaesthetic - How people learn/think
TARP	Honey & Mumford - four recognised learning styles: Theorist, Activist, Reflector and Pragmatist It helps if you understand the range of learning styles
Mosston & Ashworth	Spectrum of Teaching Styles (A-J) Used at different times with different learning outcomes/tasks and to suit learners
Kinesphere	The area that the body is moving within and how the mover is paying attention to it. Also the area in which the mind can reach!

LTAD	Long Term Athlete Development
