

UKCC Level 2 Assessment

The assessment day is your opportunity to demonstrate that you are coaching and operating as a Level 2 coach.

This process starts with you taking responsibility for organising your group of students and planning the sessions. I expect you to tell me what time to arrive allowing us half an hour to review the day before the first practical session.

The practical sessions you will need to plan for are:

- Two coaching sessions, one static (30 minutes coaching) and one as a short journey (approximately 60 minutes), one in canoe, the other in kayak.

If there are two candidates the planing will need to include a 30 minute static session each and a journey of approximately 70 minutes (allowing time for both candidates to demonstrate coaching and leading). The type of craft will need to be the same for each candidate on the journey.

- Demonstration of personal three star skills (if you do not hold a three star in both disciplines)
- Demonstration of rescue skills.

Off the water (without students) we will need time and accommodation to:

- Review the coaching sessions and portfolio including verbal questioning
- An Individual Assessment Plan is included with this letter

Please advise a suitable date by return so that I can register it with British Canoeing. Forward your portfolio (by registered post) at least one week before the day. Forward to me any information that you send to your students and directions to your chosen venue.

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
